ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 25.04.2026 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 26.03.2026 with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought point wise information in regard to complaint bearing no. ICMS/2025/041911 i.e. current status of complaint, details of police officer enquiring the complaint, steps taken in the enquiry, reasons for delay in action taken against accused, whether any notice issued to the accused, whether a chargesheet has been filed, copy of DDR's lodged in regard to complaint and action taken report.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that the RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-34, Chandigarh and part information was provided to the appellant and rest of the information was denied as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act, as the complaint bearing no. ICMS/2025/041911 was under enquiry. The applicant was apprised about the same vide office letter no. 100/RTI-26/CPIO-South dated 17.04.2026.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought point wise information

in regard to complaint bearing no. ICMS/2025/041911 i.e. current status of complaint, details of police officer enquiring the complaint, steps taken in the enquiry, reasons for delay in action taken against accused, whether any notice issued to the accused, whether a chargesheet has been filed, copy of DDR's lodged in regard to complaint and action taken report.

In reply, CPIO/South provided the information related to point no. 01-05 (current status, detail of police officer, steps taken, reasons for delay, whether any notice issued) and denied the rest of the information to the applicant, as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/South has appropriately disposed of the RTI application by applying section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act, as complaint was under enquiry at that time and providing the same could have hampered the process of enquiry.

However, complaint bearing no. ICMS/2025/041911 is still under enquiry. Therefore, requisite information cannot be provided at this stage also, as providing the same may hamper the process of enquiry. Hence, no more action is required to be taken upon this instant appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
