**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred her 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 25.04.2026 against the disposal of her RTI application dated 14.04.2026 By CPIO/North-East with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to her.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide her RTI application had sought point wise information in regard to King Immigration SCO 419, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Sector-35 C, Chandigarh i.e. total complaints against the said firm from 01.01.2018 to till date, certified copies of all FIRs registered, status of all complaints/ FIRs, closure reports of all complaints, whether the said firm is a registered or licensed firm, if yes provide copy, action taken against the said firm, whether any higher authority directions have been received regarding action against the said firm and detail of investigating police officer.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/North-East :-**

CPIO/North-East vide his comments submitted that the RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from all police stations under Sub Division North-East and the available information in record was provided to the appellant vide office letter no. 59/RTI/CPIO/North-East dated 15.04.2026.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/North-East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide her RTI application had sought point wise information in regard to King Immigration SCO 419, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Sector-35 C, Chandigarh i.e. total complaints against the said firm from 01.01.2018 to till date, certified copies of

all FIRs registered, status of all complaints/ FIRs, closure reports of all complaints, whether the said firm is a registered or licensed firm, if yes provide copy, action taken against the said firm, whether any higher authority directions have been received regarding action against the said firm and detail of investigating police officer.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, appellant has contended that the information provided is misleading and incorrect. However, the RTI application was forwarded to all the concerned CPIOs under Chandigarh Police, and the appellant has preferred the present First Appeal only against the reply furnished by CPIO/North-East. Accordingly, the present appeal is being considered and treated only to that extent.

The CPIO/North-East, in his reply, has stated that no complaint or FIR has been registered against King Immigration, SCO No. 419, 2nd Floor, Sector-35 C, Chandigarh, within the jurisdiction of SDPO/North-East. Therefore, the contentions raised by the appellant are not tenable in the present First Appeal, as the CPIO is merely the custodian of records and is required to provide only such information as is available on record.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
