**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 21.04.2026 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 17.03.2026 with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought point wise information in regard to complaints bearing no. ICMS/2026/006077, ICMS/2026/006251 and ICMS/2026/006358 i.e. copy of FIR, if registered, action taken report and any DDR registered in regard to incident dated 17.02.2026 in PS-34, Chandigarh.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-**

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that the RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-34, Chandigarh and the same was denied as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act, as the complaints bearing no. ICMS/2026/006077, ICMS/2026/006251 and ICMS/2026/006358 were under enquiry. The appellant was apprised about the same vide office letter no. 82/RTI-26/CPIO-South dated 25.03.2026.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought point wise information in regard to complaints bearing no. ICMS/2026/006077, ICMS/2026/006251 and

ICMS/2026/006358 i.e. copy of FIR, if registered, action taken report and any DDR registered in regard to incident dated 17.02.2026 in PS-34, Chandigarh.

In reply, CPIO/South denied the requisite information to the appellant, as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/South has appropriately disposed of the RTI application. Moreover, complaints bearing no. ICMS/2026/006077, ICMS/2026/006251 and ICMS/2026/006358 are still under enquiry. Therefore, requisite information cannot be provided at this stage also, as providing the same may hamper the process of enquiry. Hence, no more action is required to be taken upon this instant appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
