

09.09.2025, action taken report on complaint, DDR entry, details of police officials present on duty on 09.09.2025, reason for detaining appellant's family members at PP-56 on 09.09.2025, detail of arrest made, if any, CCTV footage of PP-56 on 09.09.2025 from 01:00 PM to 08:00 PM, copy of compromise, copy of FIR registered, if any and detail of departmental enquiry conducted against any police official in this matter, if any.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, appellant has contended that the information provided is misleading and incomplete. However, CPIO/South-West has stated that all requisite information available on record has already been provided to the appellant. Therefore, the contentions raised by the appellant are not maintainable in the present first appeal as CPIO is only the custodian of records and can only provide the information available in the record. Hence, no action is required to be taken on this instant appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
