ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 09.06.2026 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 10.05.2026 by CPIO/Central with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of DDR filed by Bishan Dass against him on 07.07.2024 at Police Post, Sector-22, Chandigarh.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Central :-

CPIO/Central vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-17, Chandigarh and requisite information was denied to the applicant u/s 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, after taking consent from Mr. Bishan Dass, who requested not to disclose his information. Applicant was apprised about the same vide no. 198/RTI-26/CPIO-Central dated 08.06.2026.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of DDR filed by Bishan Dass against him on 07.07.2024 at Police Post, Sector-22, Chandigarh.

In reply, CPIO/Central has denied the sought information as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, after taking consent from Mr. Bishan Dass, who requested not to disclose his information.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, considering the contentions raised by the appellant and from the reply of CPIO, it is clear that DDR is related with the appellant. Therefore, CPIO has inappropriately denied the requisite information to the applicant u/s 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act. Hence, CPIO/Central is hereby directed to provide the copy of DDR to the applicant strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
