ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 23.06.2026 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 22.05.2026 by CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

INFORMATION SOUGHT VIDE RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought all enquiry documents regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2025/007859.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that the RTI application of appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO-49, Chandigarh, who reported that complaint in question is under enquiry and the requisite information was denied to the applicant u/s 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act. The appellant was apprised about the same vide office letter no. 150/RTI-26/CPIO-South dated 19.06.2026.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant and comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought all enquiry documents regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2025/007859.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/South has appropriately disposed of the RTI application u/s 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act, as complaint in question was

under enquiry and providing the same may hamper the process of enquiry. However, copy of complaint and copy of statements of applicant can be provided to the appellant, which will not hamper the process of enquiry.

Therefore, CPIO/South is hereby directed to provide the copy of complaint and copy of statements of applicant to the appellant, strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act, only if appellant is found to be related with the complaint.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
