ORDER

The appellant has preferred her 1st appeal dated 20.06.2026 against the disposal of her RTI application dated 11.05.2026 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to her.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide her RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2026/002489 i.e. copy of complaint, present status of complaint, action taken on complaint, copies of statements, documents, copy of final report and copy of DDRs registered.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC and accordingly, requisite information in the shape of 10 pages was provided to the applicant through e-mail vide office letter No. 485/RTI-26/DSP/Admn dated 29.05.2026.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide her RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2026/002489 i.e. copy of complaint, present status of complaint, action taken on complaint, copies of statements, documents, copy of final report and copy of DDRs registered.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, applicant has raised grievances that entire record was not provided to her, whereas, CPIO/Admn has provided the available information in record in the shape of 10 pages to the applicant. From the perusal of entire record, it is clear that CPIO/Admn has appropriately disposed of the RTI application by providing the requisite information available on record to the applicant. However, to achieve the objective of RTI application as well as for the satisfaction of applicant, CPIO/Admn is hereby directed to provide an opportunity of inspection of record to the applicant and provide the requisite information as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
