ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 22.06.2026 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 14.05.2026 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

INFORMATION SOUGHT VIDE RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2026/011494 i.e. copy of complaint, copy of statements, copy of closure report, copy of call records as requested in email dated 17.04.2026.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that the RTI application of appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C CRU, Chandigarh, who reported that complaint in question is under consideration and the requisite information was denied to the applicant u/s 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act. The appellant was apprised about the same vide office letter no. 493/RTI/DSP/Admn dated 27.05.2026.

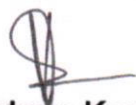
DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant and comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2026/011494 i.e. copy of complaint, copy of statements, copy of closure report, copy of call records as requested in email dated 17.04.2026.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, from the status of ICMS portal, it is clear that complaint in question has now been consigned with HAC branch after the finalization of the enquiry. Therefore, CPIO/Admn is hereby directed to provide the requisite information sought by the applicant, strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
