ORDER

The appellant has preferred three different appeals dated 18.06.2026 with regard to same RTI application dated 05.05.2026 which was dealt by CPIO/South. As RTI application is common in nature, therefore, all three appeals are clubbed together for decision.

INFORMATION SOUGHT VIDE RTI APPLICATION :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 02 points i.e. copy of DDR and compromise on complaint of applicant in PS-49, Chandigarh between 01 January 2021 and May 2024 and was the call details of this number 7061115911 extracted by Police and please provide copy of DDR and call details.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that the RTI application of appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO-49, Chandigarh and point wise reply was provided to the applicant. The appellant was apprised about the same vide office letter no. 129/RTI-26/CPIO-South dated 29.05.2026.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant and comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 02 points i.e. copy of DDR and compromise on complaint of applicant in PS-49, Chandigarh

between 01 January 2021 and May 2024 and was the call details of this number .061115911 extracted by Police and please provide copy of DDR and call details.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, information regarding point no. 01, CPIO has apprised that copy of DDR has been provided to the applicant. On the other hand, applicant has stated that no DDR has been provided to him. Hence, CPIO/South is hereby directed to provide the copy of DDR to the applicant with proper receiving.

Further, information pertaining to point no. 02, CPIO/South has inappropriately disposed of the RTI application u/s 8 (1) (J) of RTI Act, information being third party. However, from the perusal of record, it is clear that no information is available in record with the CPIO and CPIO should have denied the information to the applicant rather than invoking the wrong sections. Now, as no information is available in record, no action is required to be taken on this point.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
