ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 17.06.2026 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 27.05.2026 by CPIO/CPD with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 08 points i.e. (1) current status of police verification application AUTHMREGMR/2025/928 dated 03.04.2025, (2) confirmation whether verification was conducted, (3) if not conducted reason of delay, (4) detail of action taken with copies of noting/correspondence, (5) name and designation of the officer presently responsible for processing the application, (6) Month wise data (01.01.2025 to 30.04.2026) of applications received and disposed, (7) time taken to resolve each application during this period and (8) provide a copy of official fee scheduled for police verification services at PP-22, Chandigarh and also confirm whether any amount has been charged for police verification, by what authority and if no such fee is prescribed, confirm in writing .

COMMENTS OF CPIO/CPD:-

CPIO/CPD vide his comments submitted that part RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C Verification Branch and point wise reply was provided to the applicant vide office letter no. 18/2026/RTI/DSP/Community Policing dated 12.06.2026.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/CPD, vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 08 points and applicant through his 1st appeal has raised contentions/ grievances regarding points no. 4, 6, 7 and 8.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, information pertaining to point no. 04, applicant has stated that no information has been provided to him. On the other hand, CPIO has apprised that copy of verification report has been supplied to him. Hence, for the satisfaction of applicant and to achieve the objective of RTI Act, CPIO/CPD is hereby directed to once again provide the requisite information to the applicant.

Information pertaining to points no. 06 & 07 are concerned, applicant has sought month wise data of verification received and disposed off. However, CPIO has provided aggregated data of verifications received and disposed of during the period and stated that no month wise record is maintained of verifications received and disposed of. Hence, no more action is required to be taken as CPIO has appropriately disposed of the RTI application, as CPIO is only required to provide information exactly as it is held in the records and if data is not maintained on a month-wise basis by the public authority, the CPIO is not to create, collate, or deduce it in that specific format.

Further information regarding point no. 08, CPIO has appropriately apprised the applicant that no fee is charged by Chandigarh Police for the verification of Marriage registration. However, applicant has raised grievance regarding alleged demand of money for verification, which is non maintainable under RTI Act, as RTI Act is a platform to obtain the information available in record, rather than to raise queries. Therefore, no action is required to be taken.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
