ORDER

This is an order in connection with 1st appeal preferred by **Sh. Kuldip Singh R/o # 1410, Ground Floor, Audit Colony, Sector-41B, Chandigarh** against reply of Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO /Cyber Crime with regard to his RTI application dated: 09.06.2026.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN THE RTI APPLICATION:-

The applicant had sought information on 07 (Seven) points pertaining to complaints/Case FIR no. ICMS/2024/007128 dated 14.03.2024, ICMS/2024/010419 dated 18.04.2024, ICMS/2024/032615 dated 04.11.2024, ICMS/2025/001138 dated 13.01.2025, ICMS/2025/017045 dated 27.05.2025 and ICMS/2025/040333 dated 26.11.2025 and FIR No. 86/24, PS-Cyber.

REPLY OF Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO /Cyber Crime TO THE RTI APPLICATION:-

The Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO /Cyber Crime had submitted reply of the RTI application to the applicant on 09.06.2026, which is read as under:-

The case is under investigation. Copies of case diaries, note sheets and investigation records are exempt from disclosure under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.

The contents thereof are under examination during investigation. Further information is exempt from disclosure under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.
3.	Provide action taken on my representation dated 05.03.2026. If no action taken, state reasons in writing.	The representation dated 05.03.2026 has been placed on record and attached with

	Specifically confirm: a) Whether Sections 66C and 66D of IT Act, 2000 have been added to FIR 86/2024. b) Whether separate FIRs have been registered for ICMS No. 3, 4, and 5 as requested. c) Whether WhatsApp/Mobile number 91 94807 87602 has been corrected in the investigation records. d) Whether data from Delhi High Court registry in CS/Comm/69/2024 filed by Sequoia Capital has been collected. e) Whether the case has been assigned to a new Inspecting Officer as requested.	the case file. 4.	Provide the current investigation status in FIR No. 86/2024 dated 26.07.2024 as on date of this RTI, including whether a charge sheet has been filed and if not, the reasons for delay.	The charge sheet in FIR No. 86 dated 20.07.2024 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, PS Cyber Crime, Chandigarh, has not yet been filed as the case is under investigation.
5.	Provide the following regarding change of officers: a) Date of transfer/posting of the previous DSP Cyber, Sector 17, Chandigarh and SHO Cyber Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh who handled FIR 86/2024. b) Date of posting of the current DSP Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh and SHO Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh. c) Certified copy of the handing/taking over note, case diary entry, and file noting showing handover of FIR 86/2024 and the above 6 ICMS to the new officers. d) Name, designation, contact number, and date of posting of the current Investigating Officer for FIR 86/2024.	Copies of handing/taking over notes, case diary entries, file notings and details of officers connected with the investigation are exempt from disclosure under Section 8(1)(g) of the RTI Act, 2005. However, the present Investigating Officer is SI Gurwinder Singh, PS Cyber Crime, Chandigarh.
6.	State whether the new DSP Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh and SHO Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh have reviewed the investigation of FIR 86/2024 and the 6 ICMS and other submitted multiple my applications in the form of ICMS/Applications personally submitted by me at Cyber Crime Police Station, Sector 17, Chandigarh to dealing old Sub Inspector/IO Sh. Satyawan and then to coming IO cum Sub Inspector Sh. Gurwinder Singh and to Constable Sh. Pardeep Kumar, after taking charge. If yes, provide certified copy of the review note/order. If no, provide reasons in writing.	The case is under investigation. Any review notes, supervisory observations or internal communications relating to the investigation are exempt from disclosure under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.
7.	Regarding the direction given by the then DSP Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh through Sh. Jile Singh, Reader to then DSP Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh that the "IO has been directed to conduct investigation on a priority basis for meticulous compliance": a) Provide the date, file number, and certified copy of the direction/order/note sheet by then DSP Cyber Sector 17, Chandigarh and instructed to the IO "to conduct investigation on a priority basis for meticulous compliance" b) Confirm whether the WhatsApp message dated 11.02.2026 at 09:00 AM from 1st Reader (to DSP Sector 17, Chandigarh) stating "Instructed to IO by DSP sir for meticulous compliance", was issued in pursuance	The investigation is being conducted in accordance with law and under the supervision of senior officers. Copies of internal directions, communications, case diary entries and investigation-related records are exempt from disclosure under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act, 2005.

Provide certified copy of the official record. c) Provide details of investigation done by the Investigating Officer on a priority basis pursuant to the said direction, including dates, steps taken and certified copies of supporting case diary entries and reports. d) If no investigation was done on a priority basis, state reasons in writing and name of the officer responsible for non-compliance.	
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DECISION:-

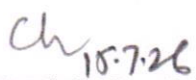
Further, the Investigating Officer has been directed to conduct the investigation in a systematic and sequential manner, conclude the same expeditiously, and take necessary legal action for the apprehension of the suspects in accordance with law. The applicant was also informed that he may inspect the relevant records/files on any working day during office hours, with prior intimation to this office. During such inspection, copies of documents permissible under the Right to Information Act, 2005 shall be provided upon payment of the prescribed fee.

- The appellant has now filed the present appeal stating that "for issuing the required directions please".
- In this regard, it is submitted that the requested point-wise information has already been provided to the appellant vide this office letter No. 35/RTI/26/CPIO/Cyber dated 09.06.2026 within the stipulated period. Hence, there has been no delay or denial of information on the part of this office.
- It is further submitted that the appellant was already informed that inspection of the relevant case files/records may be carried out on any working day during office hours. The same was communicated vide this office letter No. 35/RTI/CPIO dated 09.06.2026.
- Further, in response to the appellant's subsequent request dated 19.06.2026, it is reiterated vide No. 35A/CPIO/Cyber dated 19.06.2026 that the appellant may inspect the relevant records/files during office hours on any working day. During such inspection, copies of documents, as permissible under the provisions of the RTI Act, 2005, may be obtained on payment of the prescribed fee under the Act.

I have gone through the material on record viz-a-viz comments submitted by Dy.S.P/Cyber-Cum-CPIO in connection with this appeal of the appellant. The undersigned being 1st Appellant Authority is satisfied with the reply of Dy.S.P/Cyber-Cum-CPIO as well comments as all the available information falls under the preview of RTI Act has been supplied to the appellant.

Thus, I am on the consideration view that Dy.S.P/Cyber-Cum-CPIO has disposed of RTI application of the applicant appropriately. Therefore, instant appeal stands disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he may file second appeal before the Central Information Commission, New Delhi, within 90 days from the date of receipt of this order.
