In continuation to this office Standing Order no.42/2022/UT/P-5(Qtrs) dated 27.07.2022 regarding Government Residence (Chandigarh Administration Police Pool) Allotment Rules-2022.

They are requesting to extend retention period beyond 5 years.</p>	<p><b>Rule 13.3 (3)</b></p> <p><b>PERIOD FOR WHICH ALLOTMENT SUBSISTS AND CONCESSIONAL PERIOD FOR FURTHER RETENTION</b></p> <p>Provided further that in the cases of death of UT Police employee who was allottee of police pool house, the allotment of the residence shall not be cancelled till the case of any dependent of the deceased govt. employee is finally decided by the Chandigarh Administration for appointment on compassionate grounds but it would be upto the maximum period of 5 years.</p> <p>Competent Authority i.e. W/DGP/UT, Chandigarh has the discretion to extend the retention period upto a maximum of one year of govt. house beyond 5 years, subject to condition that family shall be charged normal rate license fee.</p>
