ORDER

(Amendment-I)

Dated 24.4.2020

In continuation to this office Sanding Order No.9/UT/P-5(Qtrs) dated 01.07.2016 regarding Government Residence (Chandigarh Administration Police Pool) Allotment Rules-2016.

2. In exercise of powers conferred by Rule-21 of the rules ibid, the undersigned makes the following amendments in the said Allotment Rules {PPH} as under-

Sr. No.	Substituted/Amended Rule (w.e.f 12.03.2020) onwards
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1.	<u>Rule(13)</u> SUB PARA MENTIONED UNDER TABLE-II (BEFORE PARA-3) In case the accommodation is not vacated by the occupant within the permissible period as mentioned against them, he will be liable to face eviction proceedings besides market license fee @ 100 times of normal licence fee for the first three months of overstay and 200 times from the fourth months onwards till actual vacation
2.	<u>Rule14(2)</u> PROVISION RELATING TO LICENSE FEE Where a police employee who is already in occupation of residence is allotted another residence and he/she occupies the new residence, the allotment of the former residence shall be deemed to have been automatically cancelled from the date of occupation of new residence. He/She may, however, retain the former residence, free of rent, in case he/she is entitled to rent free accommodation, on payment of normal licence fee up to 10 days for shifting, provided that if the former residence is not vacated within 10 days, the employee shall be liable to pay @ 20 times the normal licence fee for one month and 100 times the normal licence fee for the first three months of overstay and 200 times from the fourth months onwards till actual vacation of the former residence besides facing proceeding under Public Premises Act (P.P Act) through the Estate officer, UT Chandigarh.
3.	<u>Rule 19(3)</u> CONSEQUENCES OF BREACH OF RULES AND CONDITIONS Where the allotment of a residence is cancelled or deemed to have been cancelled on any account, the government employee shall be charged penal rent at the rate of 100 times the normal license fee for the first three months of overstay and 200 times from the fourth months onwards till actual vacation (including for the employees entitled to rent free accommodation) from the date of cancellation of the allotment and necessary departmental action be initiated against the employee



RULE 20

OVERSTAY IN RESIDENCE AFTER CANCELLATION OF ALLOTMENT

Where after an allotment has been cancelled or is deemed to have been cancelled under any of the provision of these rules the residence remains or has remained in occupation of the employee of UT Police to whom it was allotted such government employee shall be liable to pay damages for use and occupation of the residence, service, furniture and garden charges equal to **100 times the normal license fee for the first three months of overstay and 200 times from the fourth months onwards till actual vacation besides facing eviction proceedings.**

In nutshell, the word "fifty times of the normal license fee" shall be substituted, in the Standing Order, as **"100 times of the normal license fee for the first three months of overstay and 200 times from the fourth month onwards till actual vacation."**
