In view to prevent the spread of COVID 19 (Corona Virus) among people and maintain social distancing, Chandigarh Police in collaboration with Indian Robotics solution pvt. limited tested two drone systems on 08.05.2020. Sh. Ombir Singh Bishnoi, IPS, DIG, Chandigarh, Sh. Shashank Anand, IPS, DIG, Traffic & Sec., Ms. Nilambari Jagadale, IPS, SSP, UT, Chandigarh and other senior officers of Chandigarh police were also present there. The drone systems are being tested for surveillance and announcement in the affected areas. One demo was also carried out in Bapu Dham colony, Sector 26, Chandigarh.

Besides above, Chandigarh police in collaboration with rotary club Chandigarh introduced hands free sanitization systems. The system is an ingenious product and paddle based mechanical system. At start 5 such systems have been developed. They will be installed at entry points of police stations & units. They will be used for sanitization of people who come to seek police help and also for the protection of police personnel's who are battling against corona 24 X 7. This will prove to be effective in protection of police personnel as well as the public coming to the police stations.
