Today, i.e. on 27.10.2016 a special session of 2 hours (12.30 PM to 02.30 PM) on First Aid was organized in Recruit Training Centre, Sector-26, Chandigarh under the guidance of Shri Tajinder Singh Luthra, I.P.S. I.G.P., U.T., Chandigarh and supervision of Shri R.K Singh, I.P.S., S.P. Operations & Training in which 150 police officers/officials (Inspectors, Sub Inspectors, Assistant Sub Inspectors, Head Constables and Constables) of Chandigarh Police have participated.



Dr. Vandana Janmeja, Medical Officer, Police Hospital, Sector-26, Chandigarh delivered lecture to the participants and how to provide the First Aid to accident victim, poisoning cases, animal and snake bite cases, drowning cases, fractures, bleeding and burn cases. She further stated that the main aim of the first aid is to save the life, relieve pain, to promote quick recovery, to prevent further injuries and infection and to control the bleeding etc. She also sensitized about the contents of the First Aid box and how to save more lives after using these contents, as the police has the first respondent to visit at the spot at any crisis and contingency.

The main objective of the special timely on-scene action by the trained police personnel during the first few minutes of an emergency called the Golden Hours can make a difference between life & death and can significantly reduce the risks of mortality.
