## ORDER

In continuation of this office No. 11291/UT/E-2 dated 23.4.2007 vide which Standing Order No.36/2007 regarding recruitment of Constables (Executive Male & Female) in Chandigarh Police, was issued.

The following 3<sup>rd</sup> amendment in the Standing Order is hereby made: -

Sub Para (iv) below Para 4 (a) on pages 4 & 5 of the Standing Order is hereby substituted with the following: -

- "(iv) Relaxation upto Five years (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for Home Guard Volunteers provided they are working/ on roll continuously for the last 2 years or more, as on the cut date, published for recruitment in the initial advertisement as under: -
  - (I) 2 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 2 years or more as on the cut date as in the initial advertisement;
  - (II) 3 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 3 years or more as on the cut date as in the initial advertisement;

(III) 4 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 4 years or more as on the cut date as in the initial advertisement;

(IV) 5 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 5 years or more as on the cut date as in the initial advertisement."

To avail relaxation in age, as above, the candidate has to submit a certificate from District Commandant, Home Guards, in prescribed form as Annexure-1 whenever asked for during or after the recruitment process.
