

## ORDER

In continuation of this office No.11291/UT/E-2 dated 3.04.2007 vide which Standing Order No.36/2007 governing the recruitment of Constables (Executive) in Chandigarh Police, was issued.

(2) The following 5<sup>th</sup> amendment in Standing Order is hereby made :-

(3) For the existing Para No. 4(c) on page 6 & 7 of the Standing Order, the following Para 4(c) is substituted:-

<b>(c)</b> <b>Height</b>	<b>5'7" (male)</b> <b>5'2" (female)</b> <b>(i) 2" relaxation to the wards (sons and daughters only) of working/ retired/ deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees.</b> <b>(ii) 2" Relaxation to candidates who are residents of hill areas.</b>

(4) Further, the following Notes (3) and (4) are added below note (2) on page 8 of the Standing Order:-

<b>Note (3)</b>	<b><i>A candidate will be eligible to claim relaxation of physical standard either as a Chandigarh Police Ward or as a Hill Area candidate.</i></b>
<b>(4)</b>	<b><i>In order to claim relaxation of hill area, the candidate has to produce a valid certificate to this effect (Hill Area certificate) from the Competent Authority i.e. DC/DM/SDM or Tehsildar of their place of residence at the time of Physical Measurement Test. If any candidate failed to produce the same at the time of Physical Measurement Test, he will not be entitled to claim this benefit at a later stage of recruitment process.</i></b>
