



**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-TRAINING,  
UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

**Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.**

This is an order on the online First Appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/20/00033 on 17.05.2020 preferred by Ms. Neetu R/o 144, VPO Jarout, Teh. Dera Bassi, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab under RTI Act 2005, received in this office online through RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System (RTI-MIS), against disposal of her online RTI Application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/20/00118 dated 12.04.2020 by CPIO/Training.

1. The appellant, vide her online RTI application under RTI Act 2005, had requested to Nodal Officer of RTI/PHQs. to supply her some information pertaining to recruitment of 520 constables in Chandigarh Police in 07 points. Nodal Officer further transferred the RTI application to CPIO/Training and the same was disposed of on 08.05.2020.
2. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which her application was disposed of by CPIO/Training filed the instant appeal requesting that she may be allowed to inspect related documents and videography.
3. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Training have been called for. She has reported that the appellant filed an online RTI application/request on 12.04.2020 vide No. PODEP/R/E/20/00118 to supply the information regarding the CBT exam of 520 constables on seven points. The application was sent to the In-charge Recruitment Cell (CAPIO) for reply on 13.04.2020 as no record regarding the CBT exam was with her office. In-charge Recruitment Cell replied on 04.05.2020 that five candidates were scheduled for 20 December 2018 in Chandigarh, out of which 3 candidates appeared for the exam and none of them got selected on the merit list. The secrecy committee dealt with CBT exam. Hence the other desired/sought information (name of secrecy officer appointed) has been denied under section 8(1) (j) of the Right to information Act-2005. Further, the same reply/requisite information was online disposed of/sent online to the appellant on 08.05.2020.
4. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Training. The appellant, through RTI application, had sought information relating to CBT exam of 520 constables recently conducted by Chandigarh Police. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:

<b>Point No.2</b> Kindly provide me information on the reason why they were scheduled separately.			
<b>Point No.3</b> Kindly provide me information of Total 05 candidates with their name and roll numbers.			

<b>Point No.4</b> Please provide me the information of 03 Candidates appeared for the exam with their names and roll numbers on 20th December.	candidates appeared for the exam on that day in Chandigarh and none of them got selected in the merit list. Further, regarding details of these candidates, information is denied under section 8(1) (j) of the Right to information Act-2005.	information in hardcopy/ soft copy, I can pay amount for all pages.	<b>Point No. 4</b> The undersigned agrees with the information provided by the CPIO.
<b>Point No.5</b> Please provide me the information where was exam center located and was exam online or offline.			<b>Point No. 5</b> The CPIO is directed to provide the information, free of cost, within 10 days of issue of this order.
<b>Point No.6</b> Which committee was constituted for considering exam on 20th December 2018, exam after 32 days of original exam (held on 15th, 16 <sup>th</sup> , 17th November 2018) for all candidates.	<b>Point No. 6</b> The Secrecy Committee dealt with the CBT exam.		<b>Point No. 6</b> I agree with the information given by the CPIO.
<b>Point No. 7</b> Kindly provide me hash value (MD5 algorithm) of CBT of 20th December 2018 exam and which secrecy officer was appointed for generated and stored Medias and submitted the storage medias from master centralized data center to the Chandigarh police.	<b>Point No. 07</b> The desired information being the third party information is denied under section 8(1) (j) of the Right to information Act-2005	<b>Point No. 8</b> Please provide me 20 <sup>th</sup> December 2018 exam videography of exam centre.	<b>Point No. 8</b> The appellant in her RTI application had sought information only on 7 points. Now in her RTI appeal she has put forward an 8 <sup>th</sup> point. In the RTI appeal she can contest information she had sought in RTI application. She can not raise a new question/point in RTI appeal.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
