



**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-TRAINING,
UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the online First Appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/20/00032 dated 17.05.2020 preferred by Mr. Lekhraj R/o # 462, Karad Colony, Kurukshetra, Haryana under RTI Act 2005, received in office online through RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System (RTI-MIS), against disposal of his online RTI Application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/20/00136/1 dated 21.04.2020 by CPIO/Training.

1. The appellant, vide his online RTI application under RTI Act 2005, had requested to Nodal Officer-HQs. to supply him some information pertaining to recruitment of 520 constables in Chandigarh Police in 12 points. Nodal Officer further transferred the said RTI application to CPIO/Accounts vide No. PODEP/R/E/20/00136 and CPIO//Training vide No. PODEP/R/E/20/00136/1 through RTI online portal for disposal at their own level/end. The undersigned is the first appellate authority w.r.t. CPIO/Training only.

2. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/20/00136/1 was disposed of by CPIO/Training, filed the instant appeal alleging that no response was given to her by the CPIO within the time limit.

3. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Training have been called for. She has reported that the appellant filed an online RTI application/request on 21.04.2020 vide No. PODEP/R/E/20/00136/1 to supply the information regarding the CBT exam of 520 constables. The application was sent to the in-charge recruitment cell (CAPIO) for reply on 22.04.2020. The reply from the recruitment cell was received on 23.04.2020 that the sought information is regarding E-tender notice etc and related to P-4 Branch. The RTI was already transferred to the concerned branch by the Nodal Officer. So, her office was unable to transfer the RTI Application online to the concerned. However, the said RTI application was transferred to SO/Accounts, PHQ-9, in the shape of hard copy on 24.04.2020. Further the intimation was disposed of online /sent to the applicant through mail address on 25.4.2020.

4. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Training. The appellant, through RTI application, had sought information relating to CBT exam of 520 constables recently conducted by Chandigarh Police. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:



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The First Appeal bearing No. PODEP/R/A/20/00032 dated 17.05.2020 against online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/20/00136/1 is disposed of accordingly.

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
