



**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-TRAINING,
UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the online First Appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/20/00030 on 17.05.2020 preferred by Ms. Reena R/o H.No. 348, Sector-7A, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, received in this office online through RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System (RTI-MIS), against disposal of her online RTI Application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/20/00127 dated 15.04.2020 by CPIO/Training.


1. The appellant, vide her online RTI application under RTI Act 2005, had requested Nodal Officer-HQs. to supply her some information pertaining to recruitment of 520 constables in Chandigarh Police in 06 points. Nodal Officer further transferred the said RTI application to CPIO/Training and the same was disposed of by her on 13.05.2020.
2. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which her application was disposed of by CPIO/Training and filed the instant appeal alleging that she has been denied access to the information sought and requested that she may be provided information on all the 6 points.
3. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Training have been called for. She has reported that the appellant filed an online RTI application/request on 15.04.2020 vide No. PODEP/R/E/20/00127, to supply the information regarding the CBT exam of 520 constables on six points. The application was sent to the in-charge recruitment cell (CAPIO) for reply on 16.04.2020 as no record regarding the CBT exam was with her office. The reply from the recruitment cell was received on 12.05.2020 that the procedure has been laid down in Standing Order No. 01/2015 (which is available on the website of Chandigarh Police) and followed in letter and spirit as per rules in a transparent and fair manner. However the desired information seems to be in question form, which is not covered under RTI Act. The reply/requisite information was supplied/disposed of online to the applicant on 13.05.2020 on her email address on 22.04.2020.
4. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Training. The appellant, through RTI application, had sought information relating to CBT exam of 520 constables recently conducted by Chandigarh Police. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.


