



**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-TRAINING,
UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the online First Appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/20/00034 on 19.05.2020 preferred by Mr. Pankaj Kumar R/o VPO Dhurala, Kurukshetra, Haryana-136119 under RTI Act 2005, received in office online through RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System (RTI-MIS), against disposal of his online RTI Application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/20/00124 dated 14.04.2020 by CPIO/Training.

1. The appellant, vide his online RTI application under RTI Act 2005, had requested Nodal Officer-HQs. to supply him some information pertaining to recruitment of 520 constables in Chandigarh Police in 03 points. Nodal Officer further transferred the said RTI application to CPIO//Training who disposed of the same on 11.05.2020.

2. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his online RTI application was disposed of by CPIO/Training filed the instant appeal alleging that he had been denied access to the information requested.

3. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Training have been called for. She has reported that the appellant filed an online RTI application/request on 14.04.2020 vide No. PODEP/R/E/20/00124 to supply the information regarding the CBT exam of 520 constables. The application was sent to the in-charge recruitment cell (CAPIO) for reply on 16.04.2020. The reply from the recruitment cell was received on 08.05.2020. The list of eligible candidates under Ex-Servicemen category with their name and roll number has been sent on the email address of the candidate. ii) Total 50 candidates are selected are selected in Ex-service Category and only 04 candidates are still under training. Further, regarding details of marks of each candidate, information has been denied under section 8(1) (j) of the Right to Information Act-2005. The RTI application was online disposed of/sent to the appellant on 11.05.2020. Further, it is informed that due to technical problem list of ex-servicemen was not sent with the reply, so the list was again sent to him on his email address on 21.05.2020.


4. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Training. The appellant, through RTI application, had sought information relating to recruitment of 520 constables conducted by Chandigarh Police. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:

Point No. 3 Kindly provide me how many candidates were selected and are they still on training or not.	Point No. 3 Total 50 candidates are selected in Ex-servicemen category and only 04 candidates are still under training.	Point No. 3 Kindly provide me how many candidates were selected and are they still on training or not. I seek the same above mention all points detailed documents in my first appeal. Please allow me to inspect related documents. I request you to please provide me correct information.	Point No 3 The CPIO has already provided the number of ex-servicemen category candidates selected and how many of them are still under training.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
