**Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.**

This is an order on the appeal dated nil preferred by Sh. Narinder Singh r/o #153, Vill. Mauli Jagran, UT, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005 and received in this office on 22.10.2019. The appellant has filed this appeal against the disposal of his RTI application dated 03.10.2019 by CPIO/Police Lines.

1. The appellant, vide his application dated 03.10.2019, under RTI Act-2005, had requested CPIO-cum-DSP/Police Lines to supply him information pertaining to some log books of 3 vehicles of Chandigarh Police. CPIO/Lines disposed of the application vide No. 38/RTI-19/DSP-Lines(CPIO) dated 07.10.19 and denied the information u/s 8(1)(g) of RTI Act-2005.

2. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Police Lines have been called for. He has reported that the requisite information 'could not be provided to the applicant on the grounds of security reasons and the same was denied u/s 8(1)(g) of RTI Act. The intimation was given to the applicant within stipulated time period and there is no violation of RTI provision.

3. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments of CPIO/Police Lines. The appellant was contacted telephonically on 01.11.2019 and was offered personal hearing. He denied to avail the same. He requested that he should be supplied the information. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant is given below:

			these vehicles have taken away the log books so we can not give these to you, you may file an appeal with SSP saab. It is requested that photocopy of the log books of the above mentioned vehicles may please be provided to dig out the truth.

## 2. Decision of the First Appellate Authority:

The appellant had requested DSP-cum-CPIO/Police Lines to supply him copies of log books of official vehicles of DSP Harjit Kaur, DSP Amrao Singh and SHO PS-Ind. Area i.e. CH01GA 6745, CH01GA 4753(which is actually CH 01 AE 4753) and CH01GA6818 respectively. The information had been denied to the appellant u/s 8(1)(g) of RTI Act citing security reasons. Now while submitting his comments, the CPIO has agreed to supply the information i.e. photocopies of the log books of the all the three vehicles under question. He has also submitted the attested photocopies of the log books, along with his comments, to be supplied to the appellant. **The same are hereby returned to the CPIO to be supplied to the appellant. The appellant can visit the office of the CPIO on any working day during office hours and get the desired information. The CPIO is directed to supply the information free of cost. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.**

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
