ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal through online portal (bearing No. PODEP/A/E/20/00041 dated 26.05.2020) against the reply of CPIO/Central in connection with his RTI application (bearing No. PODEP/R/E/20/00158 dated 11.05.2020) with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 45/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 26.05.2020 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant had sought information on 2 points relating to his complaint No. 202003092 i.e. whether FIR is registered in the matter and allow inspection of relevant file.

Comments of CPIO/Central:

CPIO/Central submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received through online portal for supplying the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO/PS-17 and the same was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act vide No. 125/RTI-20/CPIO-Central dated 20.05.2020 as the complaint was under enquiry at that time.

Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought information on 2 points relating to his complaint No. 202003092 i.e. whether FIR is registered in the matter and allow inspection of relevant file.

In reply, CPIO/Central had denied the requisite information u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI to the appellant.

So far as the appeal is concerned, the present status of the complaint No. 202003092 is still under enquiry, therefore, the same cannot be supplied at this stage u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act.

However, taking note of the fact that appellant is complainant in the said complaint, therefore, CPIO/Central is hereby directed to arrange the inspection of relevant complaint file as per RTI Act as and when enquiry is finalized.

With these observations, the instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
