



**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE
AUTHORITY-TRAINING, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the appeal dated 12.11.2019 preferred by Ms. Geeta R/o H. No. # 1666, Sector 8, Faridabad, Haryana under RTI Act 2005, received in this office on 13.11.2019 online, against disposal of her RTI application dated 13.09.2019 by CPIO/Training.

1. The appellant, who was an aspirant/candidate in recruitment of constables in Chandigarh Police, vide her RTI application dated 13.09.2019, requested CPIO/Training to supply her some information pertaining to Computer Based Test-2018. CPIO disposed off her RTI application vide No.RTI-153/DSP-Training on 05.10.2019.
2. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which her application was disposed of by the CPIO, filed the instant appeal alleging that CPIO refused her access to the information sought.
3. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Training have been called for. She has reported that requisite information had been obtained from the office of SSP/Sec. & Traffic U/S 5(4)(5) of RTI Act and was supplied to the appellant in time.
4. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Training. The appellant, through RTI application, had sought information relating to Computer Based Test held for the recruitment of constables in Chandigarh Police. The appellant has also been contacted on her mobile number 9416740760 on 25.11.19 at 02.50 PM and offered personal hearing. She has expressed inability to travel to Chandigarh from Faridabad. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:



<p>Point No.2- How did you prepare revised result without solving omitted questions. Kindly provide me omitted questions list and their correct answers adopted for result. Provide me in hard copy and how many questions are still pending.</p>	<p>Point No.2- All the candidates were duly informed to login to the " Answer Key Grievance Redressal System" on the website of Chandigarh Police to view their individual attempted question paper and revised answer key as per their batch during the period starting from 0900 hours on 31.01.2019 to 0900 hours on 02.02.2019. Further, candidates were also provided another opportunity to raise grievances regarding the revised answer key. A total of 2185 grievances regarding 361 questions were received from 791 candidates. All the grievances received from candidates have been examined by two independent panels of subject matter experts. As per the scrutiny report of two independent panels of subject matter experts, out of a total of 700 questions of CBT, the answer key of 11 questions has been revised and 10 questions have been declared invalid. While these 10 incorrect questions have not been considered for evaluation but in order to achieve parity across all batches, the total marks obtained by candidates have been extrapolated against 100 questions. Further, revised merit list of provisionally selected candidates and waitlisted candidates of all categories has been uploaded on the website of Chandigarh Police on 28.02.2019. Candidates who appeared in CBT have been informed about revised marks obtained by them through their registered email address (given at the time of registration).</p>	<p>Point No.2- Please provide me omitted question list and still many question are pending for correction.</p>	<p>Point No.2- The CPIO is not bound to answer any questions/ queries. The CPIO is directed to provide the list of omitted questions alongwith answers. The CPIO is also directed to inform the appellant if any question is still pending.</p>

Point No.3- Which committee was constituted for making revised result.	Point No.3- The desired information is denied under section 8(1)(j) of the Right to Information Act-2005.	Point No.3- They denied under section 8(1)(j) of RTI Act 2015 for my question which committee was constituted for revised result, please allow me to inspect the relevant documents. I request you to please provide me complete details as soon as possible.	Point No.3- I, being first appellate authority, do not agree with the CPIO denying the information U/S 8(1)(j) of RTI Act. The information regarding committee, if formed, be supplied to the appellant.

The CPIO is directed to supply the information free of cost within 10 days of issue of this order. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
