ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal specifically against the reply of CPIO/Central & East in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 55/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 22.06.2020 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

INFORMATION SOUGHT VIDE RTI APPLICATION:

The appellant had sought the copy of complaint filed against him during the period 01.03.2020 to 10.05.2020.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/SOUTH, CENTRAL & EAST :

Comments from CPIO/South, Central & East have been sought in this regard. All the CPIOs have submitted that reports from the respective SHOs have been sought and they have that no such complaint was found registered against the appellant and accordingly he was informed in this regard.

DECISION:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South, Central & East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought the copy of complaint filed against him during the period 01.03.2020 to 10.05.2020

In reply, CPIO/South, Central & East informed that no such complaint was found registered against the appellant

So far as the appeal is concerned, it is clear from the CPIO/South, Central & East that no such complaint is found registered against the appellant. Moreover, report from I/C CRU has also been sought who also reported that no such complaint is registered against the appellant. Hence, no more action is required to be taken in the instant appeal and the same is hereby disposed off, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
