

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-HQs., UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the appeal dated 11.12.2019 preferred by Sh. Vijay Hans Advocate # Lex Solutions(Law Firm) House number 31, Satya Niwas Silver City, Zirakpur, Punjab-140603 under RTI Act 2005, received in this office on the same day online, against disposal of his RTI application dated 28.11.2019 by CPIO/HQs..

- 1. The appellant, vide his RTI application dated 28.11.19 had sought information relating to complaints/case against One Sh. Bhupinder Singh, Doctor(Now IAS), resident of H.No. 910, Phase 3B-II, Mohali. The CPIO/HQs. disposed off his RTI application vide No. 373, 374 & 377/DSP/Hqrs./Online RTI-19/DSP-D-462 dated 10.12.2019. He had also transferred the application to DSPs-cum-CPIOs/South, Central and East for disposal of their part of information. The undersigned is the appellate authority w.r.t. CPIO/HQs.
- 2. The comments of CPIO/HQs. have been called for. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and comments of the CPIO is given below:

3. Order of the First Appellate Authority-

I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/HQs. The appellant, vide the RTI application under question, had sought information relating to cases/complaints registered against Dr. Bhupinderpal Singh(now IAS) resident of House No. 910, Phase 3-B-II, Mohali. For complaints, CPIO/HQs. had sought report from Public Window System of Police HQs. and duly informed the appellant that no such complaint was received during the period January 1989 till 28.11.19. The CPIO can only provide the information he is in custody of. Hence it can not be said that CPIO/HQs. had denied access of information to the appellant. For registration of case, if any, CPIO/HQs. had transferred the RTI application to DSPs-cum-CPIOs/South, East and Central where the information could have possibly be. CPIO/HQs. had tried his best to trace and provide information to the appellant. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal with the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
