O R D E R

The appellant has preferred his online 1st appeal vide registration No. PODEP/A/E/20/00067 dated 30.08.2020 against the reply/order of CPIO/PHQ in connection with his RTI application bearing registration No. PODEP/R/E/20/00284 dated 18.07.2020 with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide no. 91/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 31.08.2020 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant had sought copies of complete file pertaining to complaint No. 2018-14021 dated 24.08.2018 lodged by Anita against him.

Comments of CPIO/PHQ:-

Comments of CPIO/PHQ have been obtained who submitted that online RTI application of the appellant was received in his office for supplying the requisite information of complaint No. PW2018-14021. Thereafter, record from I/C HAC branch was obtained and accordingly appellant was informed that requisite information was ready in the shape of 180 pages in two sets as sought by him and he is requested to deposit additional fee of Rs. 500/- plus postal charges for supplying documents. On 27.07.2020, appellant deposited the requisite fee online, Thereafter, requisite information containing in 180 pages (two sets) has been supplied to him vide No. 97/DSP/Hqrs/OnlineRTI-2020, D-106 dated 29.07.2020.

Decision :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/PHQ vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought complete file pertaining to complaint No. 2018-14021 dated 24.08.2018 lodged by Anita against him.

So far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/PHQ has contended that requisite information pertaining to complaint no. 2018-14021 has been supplied in the shape of 180 pages (two sets) and appellant has contended in his appeal that some pages have not been supplied to him. Hence, CPIO/PHQ is hereby ordered to thoroughly inspect the record of relevant complaint file once again and supply the requisite information to the appellant, if anything is left out earlier.

With this direction, the instant appeal stands disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
