ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal against the reply of CPIO/South in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 92/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 01.09.2020 for proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant had sought information on five points regarding poison case of Smt. Renu Yadav on 10th February, 2020 reported at 112 helpline i.e. what action taken on call received, copy of DDR, all relevant documents and copy of statements of his wife Smt. Renu Yadav etc. **COMMENTS OF CPIO/South:**

CPIO/South submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received for supplying the requisite information. Thereafter, report from SHO/39 was sought and the appellant was informed vide letter no. 279/CPIO/South dated 18.08.2020 that information of point No. 1 & 2 not falls under the provision of section 2(f) and point nos. 3 to 5 was denied u/s 8(1)(g) to him.

Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant sought information on five points regarding poison case of Smt. Renu Yadav on 10th February, 2020 reported at 112 helpline i.e. what action taken on call received, copy of DDR, all relevant documents and copy of statements of his wife Smt. Renu Yadav etc.

So far as the instant appeal is concerned, appellant has contended that he has matrimonial dispute with his wife. On 10.02.2020, his wife Renu Yadav called on 112 police help line and reported the poison case incidence. Thereafter, on 20.03.2020 his wife lodged an FIR bearing No. 10 dated 20.03.2020 u/s 498/A, 323, 504, 506 328 against him at Women Police Station Saifai, District Itawah, UP. In this regard, appellant has requested for requisite information/documents to defend him-self in the matter.

In view of above, it is clear that the requisite is directly related with the appellant and the same is not a personal information.

Hence, considering the instant appeal and in the interest of justice, CPIO/South is hereby directed that the requisite available information be supplied to the appellant as per RTI Act.

With these observations, the instant appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
