ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal through online portal (bearing No. PODEP/A/E/20/00068 dated 15.09.2020) against the reply of CPIO/W&CSU in connection with his RTI application (bearing No. PODEP/R/E/20/00391 dated 28.08.2020) with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 95/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 15.09.2020 for proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant had sought information pertaining to complaint No. 2019-23132 lodged against him i.e. Action Taken Report and copies of noting of counselling sessions conducted by IO from 29.11.2019 to till date.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/W&CSU:

CPIO/W&CSU submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received online for supplying the requisite information. Thereafter, report from SHO/WPS-17 was sought and requisite information was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act to the appellant vide letter no. RTI-307/UT/DSP/W&CSU dated 04.09.2020 as the complaint in question i.e. 2019-23132 was under enquiry at that time.

Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/W&CSU vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had sought information pertaining to complaint No. 2019-23132 lodged against him i.e. Action Taken Report and copies of noting of counselling sessions conducted by IO from 29.11.2019 to till date.

In reply, CPIO/W&CSU had denied the requisite information to the appellant u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act.

So far as the appeal is concerned, it is clear that complaint in question i.e. 2019-23132 is still under enquiry, therefore, requisite information cannot be supplied to the appellant. Hence, CPIO had rightly denied by applying section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act.

With these observations, the instant appeal is hereby disposed off, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
