The appellant has preferred his online 1st appeal bearing registration no. PODEP/A/2019/60040 dated 27.06.2019 against the reply/order of CPIOW&CSU & PHQ in connection with his online RTI application bearing registration no. PODEP/R/2019/50406 dated 28.05.2019 with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. R-119/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 27.06.2019 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

The appellant had sought information on four (04) points with regard to complaints made by Ms. Hema against him i.e. certified copy of all complaints, progress report, investigating report and statements of witness etc.

CPIO/W&CSU submitted that online RTI application of the appellant was received for supplying requisite information. Thereafter, report from SHO/PS-Women was obtained who reported that appellant had sought information pertaining to complaints made by Ms. Hema Joshi against him i.e. complaints bearing Nos. 2018-21057, 2018-20328 & 2019-01855 which have already been

sent to senior officers with the request to further send to SSP/Nanital, Uttarakhand on the request of complainant.

Comments of CPIO/PHQ :

CPIO/PHQ submitted that RTI application was received in his office from CPIO/W&CSU on 30.05.2019. Thereafter, report of I/C HAC was obtained who reported that complaint Nos. 2018-21057, 2018-20328 & 2019-01855 were sent to the Director General of Police, Dehradun, Uttarakhand vide letter No. 1582/UT/HAC dated 13.03.2019 & 2931-32/UT/HAC dated 24.04.2019 respectively for further necessary action. Accordingly, RTI application was also transferred to Director General of Police, Dehradun, Uttarakhand u/s 6(3) of RTI Act vide letter No. 276/DSP/Hqrs/ Online RTI-19, D-317 dated 24.06.2019 for disposing of the same at his end.

Decision :

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/W&CSU & PHQ vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had sought information on four (04) points with regard to complaints made by Ms. Hema against him i.e. certified copy of all complaints, progress report, investigating report and statements of witness etc.

In reply, CPIO/W&CSU had transferred the RTI Application to CPIO/PHQ. CPIO/PHQ further transferred the RTI application to the Director General of Police, Dehradun, Uttarakhand.

It is clear from the reply of CPIO/PHQ that all the complaints bearing Nos. 2018-21057, 2018-20328 & 2019-01855 filed by Ms. Hema against the appellant, were transferred to the Director General of Police, Dehradun, Uttarakhand. Accordingly RTI application was also transferred to the concerned office under intimation to the appellant. Therefore, the instant RTI appeal has also been transferred to the office of Director General of Police, Dehradun, Uttarakhand vide memo no. D-423/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 15.07.2019.

As far as the office of the undersigned is concerned, CPIO/PHQ is hereby directed to supply the copy of letters vide which aforementioned complaints were transferred, to the appellant as per RTI Act. With these observations, the instant appeal stands disposed of accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
