ORDER


The appellant has preferred his online 1st appeal vide registration no. PODEP/A/2019/60042 dated 01.07.2019 against the reply/order of CPIO/W&CSU in connection with his online RTI application bearing registration no. PODEP/R/2019/50419 dated 04.06.2019 with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 127/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 01.07.2019 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application :

The appellant had sought information on 06 points regarding his passport which was impounded by concerned authority in connection with complaint number 2016-11432 dated 23.08.2016 and case FIR no. 04 dated 21.01.2017 u/s 406, 498 IPC PS Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Comments of CPIO/W&CSU :

CPIO/W&CSU submitted that online RTI application of the appellant was received in his office vide registration no. PODEP/R/2019/50419 dated 04.06.2019. Thereafter, requisite information (in pointwise form) was obtained from SHO WPS and the same was supply to the appellant vide letter no. 261/UT/DSP/W&CSU dated 21.06.2019. As far as the appeal is concerned, available information has already been supplied to the appellant.

Decision :

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/W&CSU vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had sought information on 06 points regarding his passport which was impounded by concerned authority in connection with complaint no. 2016-11432 dated 23.08.2016 and case FIR no. 04 dated 21.01.2017 u/s 406, 498 IPC PS Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh.

In reply, CPIO/W&CSU had informed the appellant in point-wise form that passport was released from the court, notices were issued for 25.04.2018, 05.06.2018 & 25.07.2018 and all relevant documents about passport, LOC, notices etc. are not available in Women Police Station. They were sent to the Hon'ble Court as the case is under trial.

So far as the appeal is concerned, it is pertinent to mention here that appellant is an accused in case FIR no. 04 dated 21.01.2017 u/s 406, 498 IPC PS Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh and the case is under trial. So, he is seeking information in question form as per his speculation/thoughts. Moreover, CPIO submitted that relevant information has already been supplied to him in point-wise form.

In view of above, appeal of the appellant stands disposed of accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
