**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal on 29.01.2020 against the reply/order of CPIO/W&CSU in connection with his RTI application dated 11.12.2019, received on 13.12.2019 with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide no. 08/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 29.01.2020 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

**Information sought vide RTI application : -**

The appellant had sought the information pertaining to complaints bearing nos. 2013-14114 dated 21.11.2013, 2014-13108 dated 09.10.2014 and 2014-13455 dated 16.10.2014 etc.

**Comments of CPIO/W&CSU :-**

CPIO/W&CSU reported that RTI application was received in his office from CPIO/HQ vide memo no. 1681/DSP/Hqrs/RTI-19/D-1726 dated 23.12.2019 for seeking information pertaining to complaints bearing no. 2013-14114 dated 21.11.2013 etc. Thereafter, requisite record was scrutinized which revealed that complaint no. 2013-14114 dated 21.11.2013 was not primarily related to the appellant as the same was filed by Mr. Sadhu Singh R/o # 3520, Sector 22, Chandigarh against Mr. Pardeep Kumar and his parents regarding matrimonial dispute. Hence, requisite information was denied being third party information vide letter no. 623/UT/DSP/W&CSU dated 15.01.2020.

**Comments of CPIO/East :**

CPIO/East submitted that RTI application dated 11.12.2019 is not found to be received in his office.

**Transfer of 1<sup>st</sup> appeal :-**

The instant appeal is also transferred to SP/Hqrs-cum-FAA of CPIO/Hqrs as the RTI application was also transferred to CPIO/Hqrs by CPIO/PHQ vide his letter no. 2417/RTI/CAPIO/PHQ/UT/PWS dated 16.12.2019 for supplying requisite information pertaining to his office.

**Decision :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/W&CSU & East vis-à-vis material available on record



which revealed that the appellant had sought information pertaining to complaints bearing nos. 2013-14114 dated 21.11.2013, 2014-13108 dated 09.10.2014 and 2014-13455 dated 16.10.2014 etc.

In reply, CPIO/W&CSU had denied the requisite information to the appellant related to complaint bearing no. 2013-14114 dated 21.11.2013, being a third party information as the same was not found primarily related to the appellant. Complaint in question bearing no. 2013-14114 dated 21.11.2013 was filed by Mr. Sadhu Singh R/o # 3520, Sector 22, Chandigarh against Mr. Pardeep Kumar and his parents regarding matrimonial dispute.

CPIO/East also submitted that no RTI application dated 11.12.2019 was found to be received in his office.


Moreover, instant appeal ~~is~~ also transferred to SP/Hqrs-cum-FAA of CPIO/Hqrs as the RTI application was found to be dealt by CPIO/Hqrs.

It is also pertinent to mention here that appellant has filed the present 1<sup>st</sup> appeal against the reply of CPIO/W&CSU in connection with RTI application dated 11.12.2019, but on the contrary, he has attached the documents with his instant/present appeal related to an earlier RTI application dealt by CPIO/East. Hence, the documents attached with the instant appeal cannot be entertained at this stage as the two matters are totally different from each other.

So far as the present appeal is concerned, the same is being dealt only against RTI application dated 11.12.2019. Hence, CPIO/W&CSU is hereby directed to entertain the RTI application of the appellant as per provisions of section 11 of RTI act i.e. take the consent of the complainants/accused of complaint in question (2013-14114) and proceed accordingly. Moreover, as far as the information pertaining to other two complaints (bearing nos. 2014-13108 dated 09.10.2014 and 2014-13455 dated 16.10.2014) are concerned, appellant is advised to approach CPIO/Hqrs in this regard as RTI application related to these complaints was dealt by him.

With these observations, the instant appeal stands disposed of accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
