ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal against CPIO/CCIC in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The same was registered vide No. 145/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 29.07.2019.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant had sought the names & addresses of various landline and mobile phone numbers mentioned in the RTI application.

Comments of CPIO/CCIC:

CPIO/CCIC submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received through CAPIO/PHQ vide No. 1306/RTI/CAPIO(PHQ)/UT/PWS dated 13.06.2019 for supplying the requisite information. Thereafter, appellant was informed vide letter No. 45/RTI-19/CPIO(CCIC & IT)/UT/dated 03.07.2019 that requisite information was not available with Chandigarh Police is neither custodian nor originator of the information.

Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/CCIC vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had sought the names & addresses

of various landline and mobile phone numbers mentioned in the RTI application.

In reply, CPIO/CCIC informed that requisite information is not available in the record as Chandigarh Police is neither custodian nor originator of such information.

So far as the appeal is concerned, the bare reading of definition of "Information" u/s 2 (j) of RTI Act is categorically clarified that applicant can sought for that information which is available in any material form with the CPIO. However, it is clear from the reply of CPIO/CCIC that requisite information is not available with Chandigarh Police.

In view of above, CPIO/CCIC had rightly disposed of RTI application of the appellant. Hence, no action is warranted in the instant appeal, therefore, the same is filed, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
