ORDER


The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal on 14.02.2020 against the reply/order of CPIO/Central in connection with his RTI application dated 14.01.2020 with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide no. 15/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 14.02.2020 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant had sought the information on four points pertaining to the deployment of staff in MHC Room and computer operators posted in PS Sector 11, Chandigarh i.e. How many police personnel deployed in MHC Room, how many computer operators posted as CCTNS operators alongwith their duty places mentioned in Roznamcha etc.

Comments of CPIO/Central :-

CPIO/Central submitted that RTI application was received in his office on 14.01.2020 for seeking information on four points pertaining to deployment of staff in MHC Room and computer operators posted in PS Sector 11, Chandigarh. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS Sector 11 and the same in point-wise form was supplied to the appellant vide letter no. 12/RTI-20/CPIO/Central/UT dated 13.02.2020.


Decision :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that CPIO/Central has informed the appellant that four police officials and one computer operator are deployed in MHC Room. One computer operator posted with Beat In-charge. Moreover, six police officials are posted as CCTNS Operators in PS Sector 11, Chandigarh. However, copies of Roznamcha pages showing their deployment were denied u/s 8(1)(j) of RTI act as personal information disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest.

So far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/Central has rightly denied the copies of Roznamcha showing the deployment of staff u/s 8(1)(j) of RTI act as a personal information which has no relationship to any public activity or interest. Moreover, number of police officials deployed in PS Sector 11 have already been provided to the appellant.

In view of above, no more action is required to be taken on the instant appeal. The same is hereby filed accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
