ORDER

The appellant has preferred her 1st appeal against CPIO/PHQ & East in connection with her RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to her. The same was registered vide No. 161/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 02.09.2019.

As per record, appellant had applied RTI application on 20.06.2019 which was disposed of by CPIO/PHQ & East on 08.07.2019 and 16.07.2019 respectively. As per RTI Act, she can apply first appeal within the period of 30 days, whereas, she had applied 1st appeal on 02.09.2019 after the gap of 48 days on the above period of limitation.

Vide this office letter No. D-576/UT/RTI/SSP dated 25.09.2019, appellant was asked to explain the valid/cogent reason for condoning the delay within 7 days, failing which, her appeal will be treated as filed as "dismissed" without giving further opportunity.

In this regard, more than one month has passed but no response/reply of the appellant has been received till date. As such, it is presumed that she has nothing to say for justifying the delay. Hence, the instant appeal is hereby dismissed, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
