ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/Central in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 185/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 11.10.2019 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant had sought copy of status, all statements and proceedings of GD No. 16 dated 04, July 2019, PS-Sector 17, Chandigarh.

Comments of CPIO/Central

CPIO/Central submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received from CAPIO/PHQ vide letter No. 1853/CAPIO/PHQ/UT/PWS dated 05.09.2019 for supplying the requisite information. Thereafter, after obtaining the requisite information from SHO/PS-17, vide letter No. 422/RTI-19/CPIO-Central dated 18.09.2019 appellant was asked to deposit additional charges for supplying the requisite documents. Thereafter, CPIO/Central has further submitted that appellant had visited his office on 25.10.2019 and collected requisite information and he gave in writing for withdrawal of his appeal.

Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record

which revealed that appellant had copy of status, all statements and proceedings of GD NO. 16 dated 04, July 2019, PS-Sector 17, Chandigarh.

In reply, CPIO/Central submitted that requisite information was provided to the appellant.

So far as the appeal is concerned, it is clear that appellant has collected the requisite information and now he has given in writing that he did not want to pursue the matter further. Thus, no more action is required to be taken in the instant appeal; therefore, the instant appeal is hereby filed, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
