This is an order on First Appeal dated 22/08/2023, preferred by of Sh. Robin Bansal R/o Snop No. 29, F.F., Wadhwa Nagar, Dhakoli, Mohali under RTI Act 2005, received in the office of FAA-cum-SSP/UT, which was further transferred to the office of undersigned, vide no. D 251/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 22.08.2024, for the part disposal of appeal w.r.t. CPIO/Communication.

Facts:-

- Vide RTI application dated 10/07/2023, the appellant had sought information in 03 points from PIO, which was further marked by CAPIO(PHQ) to CPIO/Communication & CPIO/East, vide No. 683-RTI/CAPIO(UT)/PWS dated 15.07.2024 for disposal the same at their own level. CPIO/Communication has dealt the part information w.r.t. point no. 2 i.e. "Please provide 100 no call recording in mentioned case" and same was disposed off vide no. RTI-36/CPIO/Comn./UT dated 18.07.2024.
- 3. The appellant is not satisfied with reply/information supplied by the CPIO/Communication vide no. RTI-36/CPIO/Comm./UT dated 18.07.2024 and has filed the instant appeal mentioning therein that " I have not received the desired information/certified document as applied vide my RTI Application u/s 6 (1) within 30 days from the date of application. Hence filing appeal against non compliance of section 7 (1) of the RTI Act, 2005 in front of honorable appellant authority for justice".

4. The Comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Communication were sought vide No D- 646/RTI/SP/Hqrs. dated 22.08.2023, who intimated that the applicant alleged that he has not received the desired information within the stipulated time limit of 30 days. Whereas, the applicant was intimated vide no. RTI-36/DSP/Comn./UT dated 18.07.2024 that the applicant has not specified/mentioned the date/time, mobile number and place of accident in RTI application and without it was not possible to retrieve Dial-112 information from server database, therefore the applicant was requested to provide the above details within 10 day, otherwise his RTI application/request stands disposed off. Further no response was received from the applicant and his RTI application stands disposed off, accordingly.

DECISION

I have considered the appeal filed by the appellant viz-a-viz comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Communication. The undersigned being First Appellant Authority/Communication is satisfied with the reply/comments of CPIO/Communication. Moreover, CPIO/Communication is hereby directed to impose the relevant section before disposal of such type of RTI application as per RTI Act. The appeal is hereby disposed off.
