



**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE
AUTHORITY-CRIME, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the appeal dated nil preferred by Ms. Alka Mangal r/o H.N. 2896, Sector-38, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, transferred by SSP/UT and received in this office on 24.09.2019. The appellant has filed this appeal against the disposal of her RTI application dated nil by CPIO/Crime.

1. The appellant, vide her application dated nil, under RTI Act, had requested CPIO/Crime to supply her some information pertaining to stolen mobile phone of her daughter. CPIO disposed off the RTI application vide No.45/RTI/CPIO-Crime on 03.09.2019.
2. The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Crime have been called for. He has reported that after receiving this first appeal, a request in the matter was moved to MTMC/PHQ, Sector-9, Chandigarh for keeping the mobile phone under surveillance and they have reported "**No data found**". It means the questioned missing/lost mobile phone is still not in use after the day it went missing i.e. from 01.01.2019. He further reported that they have no objection in providing the present status report of the missing/lost mobile to the applicant.
3. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments of CPIO/Crime. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:

I have also lodged an	After going through the contents of the RTI reference as well as the record of the office of MOB, it is found that LAR No. 000179 of 2019 found to be reported online by Ms. Aditi Mangal d/o Arvind Mangal but nothing is found to be shown as missing/lost. The RTI application is filed by third person i.e. you, Mrs. Alka Mangal and not by the applicant Ms. Aditi Mangal d/o Arvind Mangal. You have mentioned in the attached application that a DDR No. 14 of Police Post Neelam has also been lodged in this regard. You have neither attached the copy of online LAR No.	The appellant aggrieved that mobile phone of her daughter Aditi Mangal was stolen on 01.01.19 from sector-17, Chg. Her daughter was in India at the time of incident but now in USA. She (appellant) being her legal guardian can not be treated as	From the perusal of RTI application and comments of CPIO/Crime it is revealed that the RTI application was filed by Ms. Aditi Mangal but the RTI appeal is made by her mother Mrs. Alka Mangal. She has aggrieved that her RTI application was treated as third party information whereas she is the legal guardian of the applicant. The CPIO has stated that actually the information could not have been supplied to the appellant because she had neither provided the copy of the online LAR nor complete detail of missing/lost mobile phone in the MOB

<p>online complaint regarding it vide complaint No. LR000179/2019. But till date I have not received any response from your side. Please supply me the latest status of the said complaint under RTI Act 2005.</p>	<p>000179/2019 nor any missing/lost item is found to be shown in MOB record. However you have mentioned the IMEI number of missing/ lost mobile phone in the reference but due to non providing the copy of online LAR as well as non-receiving the complete detail of missing/lost mobile phone in MOB, it is not possible to move a request to the MTMC/PHQ for keeping any IMEI number under surveillance. On 18.08.2019, MOB has requested you at mobile number 9914102896 for providing the copy of online LAR No. 000179 of 2019 but till date no response received from your side. Hence, due to non-providing the complete detail of missing/lost mobile phone, it is not possible to provide the requisite information to you. It is therefore intimated and suggested to file the fresh RTI with complete information so that the sought information can be provided. With this, the RTI application filed by you is being considered disposed of.</p>	<p>third party by the CPIO.</p>	<p>branch despite being contacted on her mobile number 9914102896 on 18.08.2019. After filing of RTI appeal by the appellant, the CPIO office had moved a request to the MTMC/PHQ to put the lost mobile phone under surveillance and found no data. It mean the lost mobile is still not in use. The CPIO is directed to provide information sought to the appellant within 10 days of receipt of this order. The information be provided free of cost. The appeal is disposed of accordingly.</p>
