ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/East in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 193/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 22.10.2019 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant had sought copies of visitor register of PS-26 w.e.f 01.01.2017 to 31.06.2018.

Comments of CPIO/East

CPIO/East submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office on 10.10.2019 for supplying the visitor register of PS-26. Thereafter, report from SHO/PS-26 was obtained who reported that information related to visitor register of police station cannot be supplied as it contained personal information of informers, complainants and general public who visits in the police station and by disclosing this information, it may hamper the investigation process as well as cause harms to the safety of visitors. Hence, the same was denied u/s 8(1) (g) of RTI act vide letter No. 494-RTI/CPIO/East dated 18.10.2019.

Decision :

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought copies of visitor register of PS-26 w.e.f. 01.01.2017 to 31.06.2018.

In reply, CPIO/East had denied the requisite information to the appellant u/s 8(1) (g) of RTI Act.

So far as the appeal is concerned, appellant has contended that he wants the photocopies of visitor register which contained the information of his visits from the period of 01.09.2019 to 01.06.2018. Considering this plea, his appeal is accepted. Hence, CPIO/East is hereby directed to supply only the photocopies of that portion of visitor register of PS-26 which contained appellant's visiting details of the said period, if available, as per RTI Act. With these observations, the instant appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
