
**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal against CPIO/Central in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The same was registered vide No. 192/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 21.10.2019.

As per record, appellant had applied RTI application on 02.08.2019 which was disposed of by CPIO/Central vide no. RTI-361/CPIO/Central dated 28.08.2019. As per RTI Act, appellant can apply first appeal within the period of 30 days, whereas, he had applied 1<sup>st</sup> appeal on 21.10.2019 after the gap of 55 days i.e. 25 days above the period of limitation. Vide this office letter No. D-669/UT/RTI/SSP dated 19.11.2019, appellant was asked to explain the valid/cogent reason for condoning the delay within 7 days, failing which, his appeal will be treated as filed as "dismissed" without giving further opportunity.

In this regard, more than one month has passed but no response/reply of the appellant has been received till date. As such, it is presumed that appellant has nothing to say for justifying the delay. Hence, the instant appeal is hereby dismissed, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
