

**THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE
AUTHORITY-ESTT., UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

ORDER

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on an online appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/20/00018 dated 22.04.2020 preferred by Sh. Ashok Kumar, R/o VPO- Shamgarh, Near SBI Bank, Teh-Nilokheri, Distt. Karnal, Haryana under RTI Act 2005, against the disposal of his online RTI Application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/20/00091 dated 20.03.2020.

(2) The appellant, vide his application dated 20.03.2020 under RTI Act 2005, had requested CPIO/HQs.-cum-Nodal officer RTI to supply him some information pertaining to Recruitment and Sports quota in Chandigarh Police. The Nodal Officer had transferred the application to Superintendent-cum-CPIOs/Estt., PHQ who disposed of the RTI application online on 17.04.2020.

(3) The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his application was disposed of by CPIOs/Estt., filed the instant online appeal aggrieving that the CPIO has provided him incomplete, misleading and false information.


(4) Comments of CPIO/Estt. have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Estt. and the decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority are given below:
