## **ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/CCIC with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The same was diarized vide No. R-25/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 13.02.2019.

# Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information pertaining to complaints bearing PWS nos. 2018-10606 dated 02.07.2018 and 2018-10818 dated 05.07.2018.

#### Comments of CPIO/CCIC:

CPIO/CCIC submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office from **Public** Window vide letter no. 322/RTI/CAPIO/PHQ/UT/PWS dated 21.01.2019. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from quarter concerned and the appellant was informed vide letter no. 04/RTI-19/CPIO/CCIC&IT/UT dated 04.02.2019 that the requisite information could not be supplied to him as the complaints bearing nos. 2018-10606 dated 02.07.2018 and 2018-10818 dated 05.07.2018 were under enquiry at that time hence, the same was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI act. As far as the appeal is concerned, the complaints in question, are still under enquiry. Hence, requisite information cannot be to the appellant at this stage also. 781312019

## Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/CCIC vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had sought information pertaining to complaints bearing PWS nos. 2018-10606 dated 02.07.2018 and 2018-10818 dated 05.07.2018.

In reply, CPIO/CCIC informed the appellant that the requisite information could not be supplied to him as the complaints bearing nos. 2018-10606 dated 02.07.2018 and 2018-10818 dated 05.07.2018 were under enquiry at that time hence, the same was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI act.

So far as the appeal is concerned, the complaints in question, are still under enquiry. Hence, complete information i.e. enquiry report alongwith all relevant documents cannot be supplied to the appellant at this stage also until the enquiries into the complaints are completed. Hence denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI act. However, CPIO/CCIC is hereby directed to cooperate with the appellant as he is complainant in both the abovesaid complaints and informed him about the progress of his complaints as and when he approaches CPIO's office.

With aforementioned observations, the appeal of the appellant is disposed of accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, as above, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
