**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred online 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 02.12.2024 against the disposal of her RTI application dated 24.11.2024 by CPIO/Hqrs with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 24.11.2024 had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/012774 i.e. current status of complaint, details of investigation, name and designation of IO etc.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-**

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC who reported that complaint has been sent to the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 476/ RTI/DSP/Admn Dated 29.11.2024.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/012774 i.e. current status of complaint, details of investigation, name and designation of IO etc.

In reply, CPIO/Admn had apprised about the status of complaint to the appellant.


So far as the present appeal is concerned, complaint has already been sent to the Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters and CPIO/Admn has

already provided the copy of the letter vide which complaint of the appellant was sent to Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant 1<sup>st</sup> appeal.

It is also pertinent to mention here that the appellant has raised his grievances vide his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal regarding the enquiry of complaint which cannot be redressed under RTI act and only available information in the record can be supplied under RTI act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
