ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/South in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 20/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 08.03.2022 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

Appellant had sought information on 04 points i.e. status of complaint Memo no. SDM E 202108085 sent to PS-31, reasons for not taking any action, certified copy of detailed enquiry report etc.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South: -

CPIO/South submitted that appellant has filed RTI application for obtaining information, who reported that complaint in question is still under enquiry, therefore denied u/s 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act. Appellant has been apprised about the same vide no. 53/CPIO/South, dated 03.03.2022.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had filed the instant appeal against the reply of CPIO/South with regard to sought information by appellant.

In reply, CPIO/South has denied the requisite information as per section 8(1)(h) of RTI act as the complaint in question was under enquiry at that time.

Insofar as appeal is concerned; the complaint in question is still under enquiry, therefore; the requisite information cannot be supplied at this stage. However, keeping in view that appellant being complainant in the complaint, therefore; CPIO/South is hereby directed apprise the appellant about the current status of the complaint in question as per RTI Act. With these observations , appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
