## ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 05.02.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 10.01.2025 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

## Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding dated 29.08.2018 & 28.11.2024 i.e. certified copyo f complaints, statements, records etc.

### COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC who reported that compliant bearing no. PW-2018-10492 has already been destroyed and copy of the same has also been provided to the applicant vide office letter no. 24/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 27.01.2025.

### **DECISION:-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South-West vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding dated 29.08.2018 & 28.11.2024 i.e. certified copyo f complaints, statements, records etc.

In reply, CPIO/Admn had apprised the applicant that complaint bearing no. PW-2018-10492 has already been destroyed and copy of the same has also been provided to him.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has only provided information pertaining to complaint bearing no. PW-2018-10492 and did not consider the remaining sought information. Therefore, CPIO/Admn is hereby directed to again consider the RTI application and provide the remaining information pertaining to complaint dated 28.11.2024 to the applicant as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
