This is an order in online First Appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/23/00126 dated 02/12/2023, preferred by of Sh. Rohit R/o H No. 280, Sector-2, Bahadurgarh Haryana 124507, under RTI Act 2005, received in the office through RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System (RTI-MIS), against the disposal of his online RTI Application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/23/00999 dated 15/11/2023 by CPIO/Establishment.

Facts:-

- 2. Vide RTI application dated 15/11/2023, the appellant had sought information on three different points, which are as under :-
 - 1. What is the rule of annual increment as per the recently adopted 7 CPC New Central Pay Commission in Chandigarh Police.
 - 2. How many constables working in Chandigarh Police have been given the benefit of annual increment after adopting 7 CPC New central pay commission in Chandigarh police.
 - 3. How many constables working in Chandigarh Police have not been given annual increment or are yet to be given after adopting 7CPC New Central Pay Commission Please provide a copy of the rules under which annual increment is not given. Please provide information under RTI act 2005.

The said RTI application was dealt by CPIO/Establishment and same was disposed of vide no. 350/RTI-23/CPIO/Estt. 48063 dated 30.11.2023.

- 3. The appellant, is not satisfied with the information supplied by the CPIO/Establishment against his RTI application and has filed the instant appeal mentioning therein that "The CPIO did not provide information and provide misleading information. my request was transfer to another branch and disposed of his application. Where do I get the information from other branch".
- 4. The Comments in this appeal were sought from DSP/Hgrs-cum-CPIO/Accounts & CPIO/Establishment. CPIO/Accounts has intimated that the application was transferred to CPIO/Establishment vide no. 154/RTI/CPIO(Accts)/2023/UT/80733 dated 01.12.2023, as the information was related to CPIO/Establishment. Further, CPIO/Establishment in comments has submitted that the appellant vide his RTI application had requested to supply information in 03 points regarding rule of annual increment as per 7th CPC, number of constables who have given/not the benefit of annual increment after adopting the 7th CPC and rule under which annual increment not given. As per the report of the concerned branch i.e. E-7, the requisite information in point no. 1 has already been provided to appellant, vide office letter no. 350/RTI-23/CPIO/Estt./UT/48063 dated 30.11.2023. However, information sought in point no. 2 & 3 were denied u/s 2 (f) of RTI Act 2005 as no such figure/data available on record wherein mentioned the number of constables given or not given the benefit of annual increment after adopting the 7th CPC and no such rule exists under which annual increment is not given.

DECISION

I have considered the appeal filed by the appellant viz-a-viz comments of DSP/HQs-cum-CPIO/Establishment & Accounts. The undersigned being First Appellant Authority found that the CPIO/Establishment has already supplied the information available with her. Therefore, no more action is required in the matter. The appeal is hereby disposed of.
