ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 19.03.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 06.03.2024 by CPIO/North-East with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 06.03.2024 had sought information on 04 points i.e. copy of action taken report of complaint no. 30602230000434 regarding cyber crime incident, copy of incident report, name and address of person involved in fraud and time period within which money will be refunded.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/North-East:-

CPIO/North-East vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO- Mani-Majra who reported that sought information pertains with cyber fraud and one complaint bearing no. ICMS/2023/003957 of appellant is being enquired by Cyber Crime. Appellant was appraised about the same vide letter no. 40 dated 07.03.2024 RTI/CPIO/North-East.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/North-East. vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 04 points i.e. copy of action taken report of complaint no. 30602230000434 regarding cyber crime incident, copy of incident report, name and address of person involved in fraud and time period within which money will be refunded.

In reply, CPIO/North-East has apprised the appellant that no complaint of appellant regarding cyber fraud is being enquired at Police Station Mani Majra. However, one complaint bearing no. ICMS/2023/003957 of appellant is being enquired by Cyber Crime.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO has already apprised the appellant that no information can be provided to the appellant as no complaint has been received at Police Station Mani Majra. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant first appeal.

Moreover, 1st appeal of the appellant was also transferred to SP/CCIC vide no. D-92/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 20.03.2024 for its disposal at their end as RTI application of the appellant was transferred to CPIO/CCIC to provide the requisite information.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
