ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 17.02.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 16.01.2025 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought pointwise information on complaint bearing No. ICMS/2023/026236 i.e. current status of the complaint, copies of action taken by all the concerned persons, copy of statements and details of action taken till now.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC and the same was supplied to the appellant through mail on 19.02.2025 in the shape of 07 pages vide office letter No. 44/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 03.02.2025.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought pointwise information on complaint bearing No. ICMS/2023/026236 i.e. current status of the complaint, copies of action taken by all the concerned persons, copy of statements and details of action taken till now.

In reply, CPIO/Admn has supplied the sought information to the appellant in the shape of 07 pages vide office letter No. 44/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 03.02.2025.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has already provided the available information in the shape of 07 pages to the appellant vide office letter no. 44/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 03.02.2025. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant 1st appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
