ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 28.01.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 19.12.2024 by CPIO/Central with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought pointwise information i.e. Copy of complaint given by K D Singh R/o House No. 159, Sector-9 B, Chandigarh on 19.08.2020, copy of proceedings initiated by the police/ IO against the applicant, action taken by police against the applicant and if the matter was compromised on 19.08.2020, then supply the copy of compromise deed.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Central:-

CPIO/Central vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-03 and the same was supplied to the appellant through online RTI Portal vide office letter No. 366/RTI-24/CPIO/Central dated 18.01.2025.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought pointwise information i.e. Copy of complaint given by K D Singh R/o House No. 159, Sector-9 B, Chandigarh on 19.08.2020, copy of proceedings initiated by the police/ IO against the applicant, action taken by police against the applicant and if the matter was compromised on 19.08.2020, then supply the copy of compromise deed.

In reply, CPIO/Central has supplied the sought information to the appellant through online RTI Portal vide office letter No. 366/RTI-24/CPIO/Central dated 18.01.2025.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO has already provided the copy of DDRs registered in the matter. However, appellant has sought complaint given in written and the compromise made in that regard. Therefore, CPIO/Central is hereby directed to provide the copies of same from the record, if available, strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
