#### ORDER

The appellant has preferred her 1st appeal dated 23.04.2024 against the disposal of her RTI application dated 22.03.2024 by CPIO/East with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to her.

### Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide her RTI application dated 22.03.2024 had sought information on 03 points regarding death of her brother Surinder Pal Singh on 12.10.2022 i.e. copy of statement of wife of deceased, copy of statement of Darshan Singh and copy of findings of inquiry along with the cause of death.

#### COMMENTS OF CPIO/East:-

CPIO/East vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS- 19 who reported that sought information being personal in nature. Hence, the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005, as consent was denied by the wife of the deceased. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 48-RTI/CPIO/East dated 21.04.2024.

## DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 03 points regarding death of her brother Surinder Pal Singh on 12.10.2022 i.e. copy of statement of wife of deceased, copy of statement of Darshan Singh and copy of findings of inquiry along with the cause of death.

In reply, CPIO/East denied the sought information to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/East has appropriately denied the sought information to the appellant after taking proper consent from the wife of the appellant, who stated that any information regarding her husband be disclosed to anyone, as per the provisions of section 8(1) (j) of RTI Act, information being personal in nature.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
